### Steering Committee Recommendations and Action Items

The Steering Committee considered three key topics:

- Central Basin and Range Rapid Ecological Assessment (REA) Opportunities & Challenges Review
  - The Steering Committee supported the REA review timeline and the mapping areas for conservation, restoration and development identified in the REA review.
- Great Basin LCC Science and Management Priorities
  - The Steering Committee received an update on the progress of the Science and Traditional Ecological Knowledge (S-TEK) Strategy and will receive a presentation on the S-TEK Strategy in December 2014.
  - The focal areas for the FY 2014 science investments process will be shared with the Steering Committee early summer 2014 via email.
- Great Basin LCC Capacity Building
  - The Steering Committee supported the increased capacity of the Great Basin LCC and increasing GB LCC awareness through funding opportunities received.
