A working group composed of scientists, managers and tribal representatives from across the region comes together to review the Great Basin LCC's science priorities and determine bi-annual focal topics to pursue through activities and projects.

Seek feedback

We seek additional feedback from the conservation community through an annual public forum.

Connect with the conservation community

The Great Basin LCC staff and partners are attentive to the conservation work and needs of the region and look for strategic ways to leverage resources when appropriate.

Strategic engagement

When opportunities arise to strategically address key landscape-scale conservation issues, the Great Basin LCC augments partner's resources to increase the impact of a project.

Request proposals

Bi-annually, the Great Basin LCC Steering Committee considers this feedback and helps staff develop a nationally advertised request for project proposals that address the focal topics and leverage existing resources.

Expert review

A panel of subject-area experts reviews the proposals and provides their funding recommendations.

Collaborative consensus

Staff present a final funding recommendation to the Great Basin LCC Steering Committee for final review and approval.
